 warrant & defend the said negro slaves viz Pat, Fanny,
 Bob, Hannah, & Milly to him the said William B. John-
 =son his heirs & executors against my self, & my heirs
 & against all persons who may lawfully claim the
 same or any part thereof In witness whereof I have
 hereunto set my hand & seal this seventh day of Septem-
 =ber in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred & twenty four witness present.
