& To hold all the premises before mentioned unto  
The said James H. Wood his heirs and assigns forever.  
& I do here by bind myself my heirs Executors administrators or assigns to warrant and forever defend the  
aforesd premises against all persons or persons in any  
wise claiming the said premise or any part thereof  
of in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
and affixed my seal this Eighth day of October Eight  
een hundred and Sixteen and in presence of us the  
Witneses William Wood & Lamech Edwards -
