


aforesaid for an in consideration of the Sum of three  
Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid By Edmond  
Miller of the District and State aforesaid, have  
Granted Bargained, sold and Released and by these  
Presents do Grant Bargain and sell unto the said  
Edmond Miller a plantation or tract of Land Lying  
and Being Situate in the District and State aforesaid,  
on both sides of Brushy Creek westerly of Enore River  
It Being apart of three tracts one of which was gra-  
nted to Micajah Johnston for Daniel Benet and the  
Other two Granted to Ruben Smith, and Bounderay
