 the sum of four hundred dollars to me to be paid
 by the sd B. Jones of State and District of one said to be
 on both sides of little Durban Creek begining on a black
 Oak Dead near George Lyons fence running thence S. 80°
 E. 66.50 to post oak thence W. 13. 2 18. to a stake 3 t. thence N. 70°
 W. 63. to stake on Abner Jones's line thence S. 20. W. 30.
Chains to the Beginning which include the land sold and
 conveyed to be the same more or less the land conveyed
 was originally granted to William Stul Birding - on -
 John Cannaday, Edward Howard, George Lyons, and -
 Abner Jones, together with all and singular the Rights -
 members, and hereditaments, appurtenances to the sd pre-
 miss Belonging or in any wise incident or appertain-
 ing to have and to hold all singular the premises before
 mentioned unto the sd Benjamin Jones his heirs assigns
 And administration I do here by bind my self myself
 and my executors and administrators to warrant and
 forever defend all and singular the premises to the
 sd Benjamin Jones his heirs assigns and administrators
 And also against every other person or persons who what
 sever claiming or to claim any part thereof as well
 may whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
 This 21st day of October 1823 I bind seal and delivered in
