State South Carolina Greenville District, Know all Men by these presents that I Lewis Landrith of the district aforesaid, for the consideration of one hundred dollars to me paid by Jeremiah Cleveland of said district have granted Bargained sold and Released & by these presents Do grant Bargain Sell & Release unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland one tract or parcel of Land lying & being in Greenville District on the waters of Burris Creek on a branch of the North Fork of Saluda River Beginning on a Poplar on a Conditional Line made by Jesse Mayfield & Johnston thence across said Tract of Land to a Post Oak, thence to the Back Line from thence to a Chestnut Oak Corner, thence to a Spanish Oak thence to the Beginning corner, containing one hundred and twenty acres or the same more or less being part of a Tract of Land out to Joseph Dennis: To have and to hold all and singular the above mentioned premises unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns and so here by bind myself my heirs Executors & admors to warrant And forever defend the said Land, to the said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns and against myself My heirs and assigns, and against all and Every person Whomsoever lawfully Claiming the same or any part There of in witness where of I have here unto set my hand & seal this 19th November 1824 signed & sealed in presence of witnesses J. Cleveland Jr. John Easter Lewis Landrith
