

 use & behoff forever & of the said Black man Ligon
 My Executors, administrators and assigns the said -
 Bargained premises unto the said William B. Johnson his
 Executors, administrators, and assigns from and against
 All persons shall & will warrant & forever defend by
 These presents In witness where of I have here unto set
 my hand and seal dated at Greenville Court House this
 Seventh day of September in the year of our Lord one
 Thousand Eight hundred and twenty four and in the
 Forty ninth year of the independence of the United States
 of America signed sealed & delivered in the presence
 of Alex Sloan ³
