The State of South Carolina, To all to whom these presents  
 shall come, greeting, know ye, that in pursuance of an act  
 of the Legislature, entitled, an act for establishing the mode  
 of granting the lands now vacant in this State, and for all-  
 owing a commutation to be received for some lands that  
 have been granted, passed the 19th day of February, 1791:  
 We have granted, and by these presents do grant unto  
 Samuel Earle, his heirs and assigns, a plantation or tract  
 of land, containing three hundred and eighty four acres  
 surveyed for him the 3<sup>d</sup> of June 1799 Situate in the District  
 of Washington Greenville County on branches of Saluda  
 Bounded by lines running S. E. & E. by Jesse Mayfields,  
 Land N. E. by Samuel Earle, N. W. unknown, having such  
 shape, form and marks, as are represented by a plat hereunto  
 annexed, together with all woods, trees, water, water, courses,  
 profits, commodities, appurtenances and hereditaments, what-  
 soever, thereto belonging: to have and to hold the said  
 tract of three hundred & eighty four acres of land and  
 all and singular other the premises here by granted unto  
 the said Samuel Earle his heirs and assigns forever in free and  
 common socage, given under the great Seal of the State, wit-  
 ness his Excellency Edward Rutledge, governor and com-  
 mandant in chief and over the said State at Columbia  
 this fifth day of August Anno. Domini, one thousand  
 seven hundred and thirty nine and in the twenty fourth  
 year of the independence of the United States of America
