South Carolina, Greenville Dist, Know all men by these presents  
That I John W. Bradlove of State and district aforesaid  
have mortgaged and by these presents do mortgage unto Capt  
Street Thurston his heirs and assigns a tract of parcel of land  
Laying and being in the district aforesaid on the south side  
of middle tiger River, beginning on a white oak running  
thence S. 10° E. 16 chn to a stake on Turpin's line thence with  
said line S. 0 80° E. 17 chn to a chestnut thence S. 0 25° W. 24 chn.  
With Turpin's line to a stake on the Gap Creek Road thence  
near east course with the road which is Stanfords line  
abt 42. chn to a Chestnut which is Wm Johnson's corner,  
thence north with said Johnson's line 15 chn to a stake  
near a sower wood thence 8 chn said course to a stake  
near a persimmon thence north 72° 15 chn to a Hickory  
thence north 83° W. 3 chn to the River thence up said River  
with the meanders to the Beginning to have and to hold  
the same unto him and his heirs forever and I do bind  
myself my heirs, Executors, administrators, to warrant &  
forever defend the above described premises unto the said  
Capt Street Thurston against myself and every other person -  
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part there  
of the condition of the mortgage is such that provided the  
above named John W. Bradlove shall pay or cause to be  
Paid into the hands of Capt Street Thurston or his assign or  
before the 25 day of December 1825 the sum of Seven =  
Hundred & Fifty dollars, with interest from this date being  
the amount of a certain note of hand given by the sd.  
J. W. Bradlove this day then the above mortgage to be  
null & void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue  
Signed sealed and delivered this thirteenth day of November  
Anno 1823, Wm Fuller, Peter Gerard, John W. Bradlove.
