fifty acres, be the same more or less beginning on a white
Oak running thence to a black oak corner on Hardin-
Bruces line thence on S. Bruce crossing beverdam creek
to a post oak corner, thence on S. Bruce line to a pine corne
thence on S. Bruce to a black oak corner thence to the divid-
ing line on Edward Smiths land to the branch down the
meander of the branch to M. Coots creek thence up S. Creek
to a black gum station, thence to a post oak corner thence
to a poplar corner, thence across beverdam to the beginning
which land is valued at one hundred fifty dollars together
with all & singular the rights hereditaments & appertain-
ances to said land belonging or in anywise incident
or appertaining to have & to hold all & singular the premises
before mentioned to S. Clement Ferguson his heirs & assigns
forever, & I do bind myself my heirs assigns Executors admin-
istrators to warrant & forever defend all & singular the prem-
ises before mentioned against myself my heirs assigns or
any other person or persons lawfull y claiming the sa-
me or any part there of witness my hand and seal this
3rd November 1818 signed sealed & delivered in presence
