The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that we Benjamin Smith, Thomas Smith, Abraham Smith, Joshua Smith, Pheba Sedbetter, Sary Smith, James Burges, Mary Smith, Delila Smith, Jesse Smith, James Smith, Hampton Smith, William Crumpton all of Greenville, District, in the state aforesaid, for and in consideration of Two hundred dollars, to us in hand paid by John D. Smith of the district and state aforesaid we do grant, bargain, sell and release and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto John D. Smith his heirs and assigns for ever, all that tract or parcel of land containing nine ty five acres, it being a part of a tract of 483 acres originally granted to Reubin Smith the third day of April 1786 and recorded in grant Book T J J J, page 192 situate in the state and district aforesaid on both sides of Rocky Creek waters of Enore River, this said land adjoining Capt Wal Ker, land and the said John D. Smith land beginning one several gum 3+ on the N Bank of Rocky Creek N 12. W. 20 To B 0 3+ thence N 80 E. 2, 3. to a Hickory 3+ thence S 50 E. 15. 50
