This Indenture ¹⁷⁴ made this sixteenth day of February in the year of Lord One thousand eight hundred and twenty five Between Richard Thurston of the Village and district of Greenville and State of South Carolina of the one part and Mary Crayton widow of the same place of the other part Witnesseth that the said Richard Thurston in consideration of the sum of eight hundred dollars to him paid the Receipt whereof is here by acknowledged hath granted bargained sold released and confirmed and and by these presents doth grant bargain sell release and confirm unto the said Mary Crayton and to her heirs and assigns forever an equal half or moiety of all those certain Lots of Land lying situate and being in the north westerly quarter of the Village of Greenville and known on the map of said Town as Lots no. Twelve (12) fourteen (14) and 16, said Lots having been heretofore conveyed to the said Richard Thurston by deed of Vardry Wetzel conveyed no. Twelve (12) and Recorded in the Clerks Office Book D page 145 & 146 and by deed of John Robinson son of Vardry Wetzel conveyed no. fourteen (14) and sixteen (16) and Recorded in Book D page 147 & 148.
