ing the Eastern side of the said of the said premises being
a straight line to a line known by the name of Goodwins
Old line to a fine corner thence along said line to Saluda
River, thence up said River to a line known by the name
of Charles Maxwell's line thence to the beginning
corner, to have and hold all and singular the premises
unto the above Charles Garrison, his heirs and assigns,
forever, and the above Arthur Clark do by these presents
warrant and forever defend all and singular the
above premises unto the above Charles Garrison his-
heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and
against all persons, whomsoever, lawfully claim-
ing or to claim the said premises or any part there-
of as witness where of I have here unto set my hand
and seal this sixth - day of October in the
