 Greenville District, the receipt whereof we do here by acknowledg-
 edge, have granted bargained sold conveyed and confirmed and
 by these presents do grant, bargain sell convey and confirm
 unto the said Wheaton Merritt, his heirs and assigns, all our
 respective rights interest claim and demand of in or to accor-
 tain tract or part of tract, of land it being all the real estate
 the deceased died in possession of by Estimation three hundred
 and fifty acres, more or less, situate in Greenville District on
 the waters of South Tiger River, it being the plantation where
 on the said deceased last lived being being all the parts of three
 hundred and fifty acres, of the said land more or less, granted
 as the several plats shall represent when run out Beginning
 on Wilson Bartons line on the Creek thence on Thos Bartons
 line thence up the Creek to Joseph Bartons line thence
