State aforesaid for and in consideration of one hundred
and fifty dollars, to me paid by Henry Hall, of said distric
-ct and State aforesaid have granted, bargained and sold
unto the sd Henry Hall a Tract or parcel of land contain
ing one hundred acres be the same more or less the land or
-iginally granted to Young Griffin bearing date the first
Day of December 1794, the land lying on the branches
of Enore River bounded as follows, beginning
on a stake corner, in John Moors, Spring branch made
By David M. Daniel, Tho. Springfield, and Jesse Griffin,
from thence a conditional line Northerly, to a stake
corner, on the grassy branch thence up the sd branch
to a stake corner on a line Run by George Salmon,
thence S. 6 E. to a light wood stake corner, thence
S. 81 E. to a chestnut corner thence to the head of
the Strait prong of the beginning branch thence down
the sd branch to the beginning corner Together with
all and singular the Rights, numbers, hereditaments,
and appertinances, to the sd premises belonging or in
any wise appertaining, to have and to hold all and
singular the premises before mentioned unto the sd
Henry Hall, and I do here by bind myself my heirs exe
-cutors admors and assigns, to warrant and forever defend
the above mentioned premises, from me and my
Heirs and from any other person or persons, lawfully
-lly claiming, the same or any part thereof to the
said Henry Hall, and his heirs forever, in witness where
unto I have set my hand and seal this 9th of Sept-
ember 1809, signed sealed and Delivered in presents
of Elliott Clardy, John Battson, Jesse Griffin (Seal)
