The State of South, Carolina, to all to whom  
these presents shall com, greeting, Knowye, that in  
pursuance of an act of the legislature, entitled  
an act for establishing the mode of granting  
the lands now vacant in this state, and for allow-  
ing a commutation to be received for some lands  
that have been granted, passed the 19th day of  
February, 1791; we have granted, and by these pres-  
ents do grant unto Nelson Dickerson his heirs  
and assigns, a plantation or tract of land  
containing four hundred & fifty eight acres  
surveyed for him the 22. of August 1818 situate  
in Greenville district on the branches of the  
Golden Grove, & Rudysfort, having such shape  
form and marks, as are represented by a  
aptat here unto annexed, Together with all  
Andrew Pickens's woods, trees, waters, watercours,  
profits, commodities appurtenances and  
hereditaments what soever there unto belonging
