This is to testify to all people whom it may concern that on the thirteenth day of January one thousand eight hundred and fourteen that I Keganah Pickett then of Fairfield district did sell and delivered to James Pickett of North Carolina Rutherford County two negroes viz Jim & vilet during of my natural life and at my decease the said negro viz Jim and vilet was to be returned if living as my estate further the said James was to pay me forty two dollars per year during of my life under a contract to that effect which was to be paid yearly to me by the said James let me live when soever I might as a part of my support of boarding & maintenance as the case might be & which if the negroes viz Jim & vilet had never died the forty two dollars for each year was not to cease but this is to shew to all persons whom it may concern that I Keganah Pickett have been under the care and maintenance of my son James Pickett commencing on this thirteenth day of January one thousand eight hundred and fourteen and continued with him until the first of January one thousand eight hundred and twenty three during of which time I have recd of the said James Pickett forty two dollars every year as a part of the payment due him for my boarding and this is to shew to all persons whom it may concern that the balance of my annual boarding is yet to pay to my son James Pickett counting from the said thirteenth day of January one thousand eight hundred and fourteen until the first day of January one thousand eight hundred and twenty three and this is further to shew to all persons whom it may concern that on the first day of January one thousand eight hundred and twenty three I Keganah Pickett did receive from the said James Pickett the two negroes viz Jim and vilet as the property of my estate in full of all demands I have a gainst said James Pickett up to the first of January 1823 I Keganah Pickett doth hereby also quit claim to the forty two dollars which my son James Pickett was to pay me during of my life as I have made that contract of the negroes viz Jim & vilet during of my life null and void also all my contracts previous to the to the first day of January 1823 all to cease with with my self & my son James Pickett which I Keganah Pickett have hereby finally quit claim in every respect a gainst my son James Pickett previous to the first day of January one thousand eight hundred and
