South Carolina Greenville District February 23<sup>rd</sup> 1825  
we the legal heirs and heirs at law of the estate of Moss  
Hemp deceased, do grant release and forever quit,  
claim, unto Pleasant Hudson, legal heir of S<sup>c</sup> dec'd. all  
that tract or parcel of land originally granted to  
Henry Hughs, bearing date February the 5<sup>th</sup> 1778 which  
in tract or runs into the bounds of a certain tract  
or parcel of land containing according to conveyance  
of one Hundred acres, it being a part of a tract contain
