


in hand paid by Robert Hawkins, have bargained & sold

 hereby authorize and empower the said Robert Hawk-  
 ins to demand and receive of and from the Executors  
 of the said will and all other persons the portion of  
 said Land to which I may be intitled to on the death  
 of Catherine Hawkins, and also the amount which  
 may be due to me under the will aforesaid out  
 of the proceeds of the sale of the said Land if the  
 same should be sold in presence of witness my  
 hand and seal this 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1825
