 paid by John T. Peden of the State and district aforesaid
 have granted bargained sold and released, and by
 these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto
 the said John T. Peden a plantation or tract of land lying
 in the State and district aforesaid on the waters of Rudey
 River Beginning on a post Oak 3^t on the old Indian
 boundary line thence running down a draw to the head
 of the said John T. Peden Spring branch thence down
 the meanders of said branch about 24 to a black Gum
 3^t thence N. 45. 40^w to a white Oak 3^t thence South 3. 50
 to a rock 3^t thence S 48 E 3. 88 to a poplar 3^t on the
 bank of a small creek thence down the meanders
 of said creek about 23 to a Stake 3^t on the old line thence west
 7. 70 to a Stake thence south 24. 50 to a Stake 3^t thence East 15 to a
 black oak 3^t thence N. 35 E. 21 to a red oak 3^t thence N. 52 E. 10. 70
 to a pine thence East 13. 50 to a Stake on the old boundary line thence
 North along said line 32 to the Beginning bounded on the north
 by the said Alexander Peden on the west by John Stennepson
 the south by William Choice and on the east by Tully T. Sullivan
 & Co including the house and plantation where the said
 John T. Peden now lives with one hundred and thirty eight
 acres of land be the same more or less together with all and
 singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances
 to the same belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining
 thereto and to hold all and singular the premises above men-
 tioned unto the said John T. Peden his heirs and assigns forever
 and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and ad-
 ministrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular
 the said premises unto the said John T. Peden from my self
 and my heirs and from every person whomsoever lawfully cla-
 iming or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my
 hand and seal this twenty fourth day of January in the
 year of Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty
 five and in the forty ninth year of the American indepen-
