Sullivan one Grey Steed horse, one bay mare, one feather bed, Steed and furniture, rifle Gun, 1 Shot-Gun, 2 pots, 1 oven, 2 putter dishes, 6 plates & 2 Culebard with same glasses and Tin ware & Earthen ware 6 Chears, some Bacon, 10 set knives & forty and 1 set Spoons to have and to hold the above named property to them the said J. Sullivan & Co and Hewlet Sullivan their heirs and assigns forever provided never the less and it is expressly understood that if the said Wm Scott his heirs Executors or administrators shall and do, will and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Joseph Sullivan & Co and Hewlet Sullivan their heirs or assigns the said promissary note & accounts of one hundred and twenty dollars and sixty four cents together with the interest arising thereon on or by the march next then the above Mortgage or bill of sale to be void and of none effect otherwise the said J. Sullivan & Co and H. Sullivan their heirs Exrs & assigns hereby authorized to take immediate possession of said horse mare, Bed & furniture, Gun, pots, oven dishes, plates, Culebard, glasses, tin, crockery ware, chears - Bacon, knives, forty and 1 set Spoons and proceeds to sell the same conformably to Law for the purpose of discharging said sum of one hundred and ten dollars and sixty four cents, with the interest thereon returning the overplus if any there shall be to the said Wm Scott witness my hand and Seal this 4 March 1825
