and thirty one dollars to me in hand paid by Thomas
Edmondson of the State & best of ore said
have granted bargained sold & conveyed unto
the said Thomas Edmondson all that plantation
and tract of Land containing one hundred and
seven ty five acres more or less situated & lying
in the District a fore said on the waters of the
north fork of Saluda river, and is bounded as
follows a conditional line beginning on a black
oak in Hugh Mcveys line thence a straight
course to black oak bearing thence a straight
line to Dogwood corner & spring branch thence
down the meanders of S. branch to the mouth
of the same where it empties into the lower dam
creek to William Kellogg line thence a long his
line to where it joins Hugh Mcveys line
thence a long the S. Mcveys line to the
beginning of to have and to hold from me my
heirs executors administrators or assigns for ever
to said Edmondson his heirs or assigns, which I
warrant and defend the same from any person
or persons lawfully claiming or to the same grant
let my hand & seal this the 16th day of November
one thousand eight hundred & sixteen and in the
fortieth & forty first year of the Independency
of the U. S. State of America signed & delivered
