and District on waters of Tayboms Creek of  
Reedy River to contain thirty acres being a  
part of a tract originally granted to John  
Wick by to be laid off to contain thirty acres  
& no more to begin at the corner marked  
in the original a red oak which is now  
gone but the place for a line the said  
Mortons field thence along the original  
Line N. 67.° W. a sufficient distance to  
make the thirty acres by turning a square  
from said line to the original line running  
S. 55.° W. as on reference to the original and  
observing on the premises well more fully  
appear together with all and singular the  
Rights members & appurtenances to  
the said premises belonging or in any wise  
incident or appertaining to have & to hold  
the premises as above described unto the said  
Morton his heirs & assigns for ever & I do  
hereby bind my self my heirs Executors &  
Administrators to warrant & for ever defend  
the same unto him his heirs and assigns
