and in consideration of the sum of the sum of Forty dollars to me
in hand paid by James Bennie of the same place have bargained
sold and by these presents do bargain and sell all that plantation
or tract of land lying and being in the State & district aforesaid on some
of the head branches of Mountain and Beaver dam creek, water of Enoree
River and some branches of Rudy River bounded S.E. & N.E. on John
Salmon, Maddell, Phillips and vacant land No. by Jno. Batson & Jael Blachly,
N.E. & East by vacant land, the same containing three hundred and ninety two
acres, less the same more or less, the same being originally granted to the
said Land Duncan by his Excellency Thomas Bennett Esq; Governor and
Commander in Chief for the time being the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
edged I have granted bargained sold and by these presents do grant
bargain and sell, release confirm and convey unto the said James Bennie
all the aforesaid tract of three hundred and ninety two acres of land
unto the said James Bennie his heirs and assigns forever together with all and
singular the H�dements, And appurtenances to the said premises belonging
or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the said
premises above mentioned unto the said James Bennie his heirs and assigns
forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators
to keep harmless and secure the right and title of the aforesaid tract of
three hundred & ninety two acres of land against all persons lawfully
claiming or to claim under me or them. In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and affixed my seal this 28th day of November one thousand and
eight hundred and twenty five signed sealed & delivered at Impression
of my John Young Lewis & Young³ Samuel Duncan ^{Seal}
