to a Post Oak thence N.55.E 13 to the road then down the road to
the beginning which includes the lands herein to be conveyed being
eighty acres together with all and singular the rights, members and
appertaining unto the said premises belonging or in any wise in-
cluded or appertaining To Have And To Hold the said premises unto
the said David T. Curton his heirs & assigns forever & I do hereby bind
myself my heirs & to warrant & forever - the said premises unto the said
David T. Curton against myself my heirs & against all and every person
or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any
part thereof Witness my hand and seal this 6th November 1825 -
