

her future increase, as the Separate and property of my said wife, &c and during her natural life, and at her death, of right to belong to any said daughter, and her heirs forever, freely granting to my said Trustees or either of them full power and authority to ask demands, &c for and recover the said Estate of any person whatsoever into whose hands this sum may fall, and apply the same Estate to the uses aforesaid: Whereby having paid all my just debts and demands, divesting myself of all right and title to the same, and investing the right therein in my said Trustees for the uses aforescribed.

1825 and in the fiftieth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States

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The State of South Carolina Greenville District. Know all men by these pre-
sents that I Alesalom Gaudle of the State and district aforesaid in consideration
of the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars to me paid by Tully Bolling of the State
and district aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these
presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Tully Bolling a pla-
ntation and tract of land lying in the State and district aforesaid on the water
of Mountain Creek waters of Saluda River Beginning on a post oak 3x three
N. 5. E. 22. 75. to a pine 3x bounding on land surveyed for William Wood thence
N. 79. E. 20. to a Stake 3x three N. 60. E. 15. 90. to a Stake 3x bounded by Archabald
McDonald's land three Y 19. E. 25. 80. to a post oak 3x bounded on Tully Bollings
end three Y. 25. W. 14. 20. to a Stake 3x bounded on Luke Brumton's land three
N. 45. W. 5. 50. to a red Oak 3x three N. 89. W. 31. 20. to the Beginning bounding on Hare
Kins land it being part of two tracts of land one granted to John McDonald
7 15 3/4 acres on the 3rd day of December 1804 the other of 96. Acres surveyed for
Redden Hall on the 11th day of January 1818 including one Hundred and Twelve
acres of land more or less and being conveyed from the said Redden Hall

... I also declare this from him to William Barrett and from him to the said Abra-
ham Caudle and now from him to the said Tully Bolling Together with
all and singular the Rights members hereditaments and appertaining to the said
premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold
all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Tully Bolling his
heir and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and ad-
ministrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the
said Tully Bolling his heir and assigns from myself and my heirs and from every per-
son whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof witness
my hand and seal this Twenty ninth day of March in the year of our Lord one tho-
sand eight hundred and twenty two and in the forty sixth year of the Indepen-
dence of the United States of America Signed sealed acknowledged
