E. to a black oak wt on James Robinsons line thence a strait line to the  
Beginning wt together with all and singular the rights numbers hereditaments  
and appertances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appur-  
tenant to have and to hold all and singular the said premises above men-  
tioned unto the said Isaac West his heirs and assigns forever and we do  
hereby bind ourselves our Heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant  
and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Isaac  
West his heirs and assigns forever against ourselves our heirs and against  
every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or  
or any part thereof In witness whereof we do hereunto affix our hands and  
Seals this 22nd day of November Anno domini 1819 signed sealed and
