

And by these presents do Grant Bargain sell and release unto the said McCaffee two plantations or tracts of Land lying and being in the District aforesaid on both sides of the south fork of Yegge River containing One Hundred and forty four acres more or less and bounded as follows The one on the N. W. by land laid off Mary Turner all other sides vacant Land the other a part of said Mary Turners tract the first beginning on a Poplar thence S 36. E 37. 20 to a Stake thence N. 83 W. 27. 00 to a red oak thence N. 45. 10 to a dogwood thence N. 30. W. 18 to chestnut thence N. 19. 00 Hickory thence E. 27. 50 to the beginning the other beginning on a black oak thence fifty one chains to a black oak oak thence East 25. 00 to a black Oak thence E. 27. 50 to a post oak then a conditional line to the beginning together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to said Land and premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the land and premises before mentioned unto the said John McCaffee his heirs and assigns forever and I do here by bind myself my heirs Exors & Adms to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said McCaffee his heirs &c. against myself my heirs or any other person or Persons lawfully claiming the same In witness my hand and seal this Twenty seventh Nov. 1822 West Wheaton Merritt, Alfred Merritt, Jeremiah Forrest
