 Certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in the District of Greenville
 on both sides of Mill Creek beginning at an ~~an~~ agreed corner on John
 Mcblers line thence to a post oak corner on said line thence No.
 64 E. 25. ch. along said line to a persimmon thence so 25. E. 5 ch to a Post
 Thence so 5. W. 25. ch & 20 links to a stake thence W. 14 ch & 60 links to a post ch. Thence
 Thence by an agreed line to the beginning supposed to contain one hundred
 & thirteen acres be the same more or less Together with all and singular the
 Rights members Hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging
 or in any wise incident to have and to hold all & singular the before mentioned
 Premises unto him the said Hickman his heirs & assigns for ever & I do hereby
 Bind my self my heirs Executors Adms. to warrant & for ever defend all
 & singular the before mentioned premises unto him the said Hickman his heirs
 & assigns against my self my heirs & against every other person whomsoever
 Lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my hand
 & seal this 30 day of March in the year one thousand eight hundred & thirteen
