 place have granted bargained sold & released and by these presents  
 do grant bargain sell & release to the aforesaid Lewis Bridges all my  
 part of the real estate of the said Eaton Hawkins wherein Catharine  
 Hawkins widow of the aforesaid deceased now lives, and I do hereby renounce  
 and release all my part of the aforesaid estate viz the land contain-  
 ing about two hundred acres lying and being in the District of Greenville  
 State of South Carolina on the waters of Reedy River adjoining land of  
 Pink Hawkins, Mrs Wynne & others near the Parishes maintain &c and it is ex-  
 pressly understood that the said John Upchurch do by these presents and it is  
 the intent and meaning of this instrument of writing to convey to the said  
 Lewis Bridges all the interest I have in the before mentioned estate  
 to which I am in any way entitled to by the last will of the said Eaton  
 Hawkins as fully as if this conveyance were more fully expressed <sup>& truly</sup> together with  
 all and singuly the right, members, hereditaments & appurtenances therunto belonging  
 or in any wise appertaining to have & to hold all and singular the said premises  
 to the said Lewis Bridges his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind my  
 self my heirs executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend the  
 said premises unto the said Lewis Bridges his heirs and assigns and from me &  
 my heirs & assigns and from every other person lawfully claiming or to claim  
 the same or any part thereof In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my  
 name & affixed my seal this the 5<sup>th</sup> day of July in the year of our Lord  
 One thousand eight hundred & twenty five and in the 50<sup>th</sup> year of the indepen-  
 dence of the United States of America signed sealed and delivered in  
 presence of Richard Wynne Ezekiel Hawkins & John <sup>his</sup> Upchurch <sup>Seal</sup>  
 South Carolina Personally appeared Ezekiel Hawkins to me in the subscriber and  
 Greenville District made oath that he saw John Upchurch sign seal and acknowledge  
 the within deed of conveyance to Lewis Bridges for the uses and purposes therein  
 mentioned and that Richard Wynne was a subscribing witness to the same —  
 Sworn to this third day of April A.D 1826 before —  
 me J H Goodell C.C. p & I.D. Ezekiel Hawkins —  
 Recorded for the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1826

Know all men by these presents that I Elkanah Wills of the State of South Carolina  
 Greenville District for the consideration of two hundred and sixty dollars to me in  
 hand paid by Elizabeth Bowen of the State and district hath bargained and sold  
 & by these presents do bargain, sell and confirm a certain tract of land situate on  
 Brushy Creek of Reedy River it being a part of a tract originally granted  
 to Jameson Lehaner by his Excellency William Moultrie Governor in and over  
 the said State and conveyed by the said Chandler to Gilbert Sweat from him  
 to William Blythe and from the said Blythe to William Rauntree and from the  
 said Rauntree to Adam Barrell and from him to me Beginning at a Stake  
 from thence up A.R. Parkins line to a black oak corner thence turn down  
 to ward the former line to a black oak corner from thence to a black  
 Jack up the old line to the beginning containing fifty acres more or less
