of Seven Hundred dollars paid by Samuel Hill of the same place have  
granted Bargained sold and released and by these presents do Grant  
Bargain and Release unto the said Sam'l B. Hill for the proper interest use  
and behoof of William B. Hill, The tract of Land wherein I now live in  
said district on the head branches of Rayborn creek containing Two Hh.  
and fifty acres be the same more or less. — Beginning on a Beach thence  
thence N. 10° E. 38. on Robert Peden to a Hickory tree thence N. 85. W. 65. on James  
Alexander to a red oak 3x thence S. 10° W. 26. to a Stake on Thompson line  
thence along the same S. 67° E. 49. to a Stake on Morton line, thence on  
Morton line N. 81. E. 24 chain to the Beginning. To have and to hold the  
said tract of Land as described unto the Hill, for the said interest and  
use trust to his heirs & assigns forever, with all and singular the rights  
members hereditaments and appurtenances belonging or in any wise inci-  
-pient or appertaining to the same, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs  
executors &c to warrant and defend the premises as described unto the said Hill  
and his against all manner of claims whatsoever, In witness whereof I have  
hereunto set my hand and affixed day seal this 15<sup>th</sup> of Nov. 1819. — Signed
