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 South Carolina To all to whom these presents shall come, I, Nimrod Underwood
 Sheriff of Greenville District, and State aforesaid, send greeting: Whereas, by virtue of three—
 writs of fieri facias, issued out of the Court of Equity held for the District of Spartanburgh
 tested the twenty seventh day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
 and twenty six Wm. H. Powell and Abner McKie to one directed, commanding me, that of the
 goods and chattles, lands and tenements of Daniel McKie, to levy the sum of one hundred and
 thirty Eight dollars & ³/₁₀₀ damages and costs, I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements
 parts of the said Daniel McKie all that certain piece parcel and tract of Land, contain-
 -ing three hundred Hundred Acres more or less situate and being in the district of Greenville
 in the State aforesaid on each side of Rocky creek waters of Enoree River being part
 of two tracts of Land originally granted to David Lewis and Nathaniel Walker, one
 Hundred acres of the land now intended to be conveyed was conveyed by the said David
 Lewis to Blagrove Glenn by deed bearing date the 19th March 1810. which is Recorded
 in Book H. page 343. And Two Hundred acres conveyed by William Harbin Junr to the
 said Blagrove Glenn by deed bearing date 15th March 1810. and is Recorded in Book H. page 348.
 and both of which tracts are conveyed by said Blagrove Glenn by deed bearing date
 March 1812 to Daniel McKie bounded on the south by lands of Benj. Smith North &
 North west by Thomas Hutchings East by lands of Wm. Richard. And whereas, the
 said premises, with their appurtenances, since the seizure by me made, by virtue of the said
 writs of fieri facias before mentioned, have been exposed to sale at public vendue, and
 purchased by Lester Richard of the District of Greenville aforesaid for the sum of
 one hundred and forty one dollar being the highest sum that was bid therefor
 Now know ye, that I, Nimrod Underwood Sheriff aforesaid, by virtue of the said
 writ of fieri facias aforesaid, to me directed and delivered as aforesaid
 and by virtue of the Statute in such case made and provided, and for and in
 consideration of the said sum of one hundred and forty one dollar, to me
