Know all men by these presents that we Josiah Culbertson Senior and Martha Culbertson his wife of Damp County and state of Indiana for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars current money of the United States paid by Josiah Culbertson Junior, the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge have given granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do give, grant, bargain, sell a clean release convey and confirm unto the said Josiah Culbertson Junior his heirs and assigns forever a certain piece or parcel of land lying and being in Greenville District South Carolina designated bounded butted and described as follows to wit beginning at a post oak corner being the South East corner of a survey of Eight hundred and twenty two acres originally granted to William Davis Thomas thence north 26 East to George Salmons corner thence westwardly along said Salmons line to his South West corner at or near the head of the Rocky branch thence South five west to the South boundary line of said Thomas survey; thence East along said line to the said place of beginning containing two hundred acres more or less To Have and to hold the above granted and bargained premises with the privileges and appertinances thereof and thereto belonging, to him the said Josiah Culbertson Junior his heirs and assigns to his and their own proper use benefit and behoof for ever and we the said Josiah Culbertson Senior and Martha the wife of the said Josiah for our selves our heirs Executors and administrators do covenant to and with said Josiah Culbertson Junior his heirs executors, administrators and assigns that until the sealing hereof we were and are lawfully seized and possessed of the above described premises in fee simple that they are free of all encumbrances that we have good right and lawful authority to sell and convey the same to the said Josiah Culbertson Junior in manner and form aforesaid and that we will warrant and for ever defend the same to the said Josiah Culbertson Junior his heirs and assigns against all lawfull claims and demands of any person or persons whatever.
