lawful attorney for us and in our names to grant bargain and sell all our right title
Claim and interest in and to two tracts of land lying and being in Grunville District State of
South Carolina which land duded from Levi Ford deceased to the above named John
Ford and Prussia Ford now Pippia Kirkpatrick and wife of the above named Lewis
Kirkpatrick as heirs of the said Levi Ford and we the said John Ford and Lewis
Kirkpatrick do hereby authorize and empower the said Bayley Butler to do and
perform any act or acts thing or things whatsoever that shall be needfull or
necessary to be done touching or in any wise concerning the aforesaid Land or in the
conveying or assigning thereof to the purchasers in as full and ample a manner
to all intents and purposes as we the said John Ford and Lewis Kirkpatrick might
or could do if we were then and there personally present and also ratifying allowing
and confirming all and whatsoever acts and things our said attorney shall do or
cause to be done by virtue and according to the true intent and meaning of these
presents and we hereby further authorize and empower our said attorney for us and
in our names to ask for demand or sue for all debts due to the Estate of the
said Levi Ford deceased and to execute receipt and acquittance for the same
and to do all other acts and things necessary or needfull to be done relative to the
said Estate according to the true intent and meaning of these presents Intestacy
Whereof we have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals the 1st day of April
