South Carolina To all to whom these presents shall come, I, Nimrod Under-
wood Sheriff of Greenville district, and State aforesaid, send greeting:
Whereas by virtue of three writs of fieri facias, issued out of the Court of
Common pleas, held for the district of Greenville tenth the first manday
after the 4th Manday in March & in October in the years of our Lord one thousand
said Eight hundred and twenty one & twenty six at the suits of Jeremiah Blaw-
land and Thompson M. Prince to me directed commanding me that of the
goods and chattels lands and tenements of Joseph Turner to levy the sum
of Eight hundred and Eighty two dollars & 15 cents with damages and costs.
I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said Joseph Turner
all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land containing two hundred
and eighty acres more or less situate and lying in the district of Greenville
and State aforesaid on Hooper Creek of Saluda River; Beginning on a
red oak on Fairline thence N. 78° 10' 60" E to a hickory thence N. 22° 10' 17" E to
a small red oak thence N. 42° + E. 22' 60" E to a red Oak on Isaac Bradleys
line thence N. 53° E. 32' 60" E to a red Oak thence N. 41° E. 12' 60" E to a Red
Oak near the mile Post thence S. 13° E. 7' 60" E to a post Oak thence S. 10° E. 19' 60"
go links to a pine stump thence S. 80° E. 16' 60" E to a post Oak thence S. 9. 10'
20' chain to the beginning Oak on Fair line And whereas, the said
premises, with their appurtenances, since the seizure by me made by virtue of
the said writs of fieri facias before mentioned, have been exposed to sale at
public vendue, and purchased by Jeremiah Blawland ser. of the District
and State aforesaid for the sum of two hundred and Eight dollars being
the highest sum that was biddeid therefor. Now know ye that I, Nimrod
Underwood Sheriff aforesaid, by virtue of the said writs of fieri facias afo-
resaid to me directed and delivered as aforesaid, and by virtue of the Statute
in such case made and provided and for and in consideration of the sum
sum of two hundred and Eight dollars to me in hand paid or secured
to be paid by the said Jeremiah Blawland. Now the receipt and payment
whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and
by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Jeremiah Blaw-
land and his heirs and assigns for ever, the said tract, piece and parcel
of land, with its appurtenances and all the Estate right, title and interest
which the said Joseph Turner of Right had of in and to the same
