situate lying and being on the North East Side of the Golden Grove creek
on the Boiling Mill branch begining on a poplar corner x3 from thence down
the main Grove creek to a Chinupin corner x3 at Ambrase Blackburns
old Bridge from thence along the line S.E. from thence up the hollow
up to the waggon road by the meeting house where John Bowers line crosses
the said road from thence along the said Bowers line N.E. to a Hake corner from
thence a straight line to a stone corner on the Boiling Mill branch W.E. from
thence South west down said branch the Hork from thence a condtional line
marked N.W. to the begining corner. Together with all and singular the
rights members and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise incident
or appertaining To Have and to hold all and singular the premises a
bove mentioned to the said John Townsend his heirs and assigns forever
And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant
and for ever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned to
the said John Townsend his heirs and assigns forever against me and my
heirs and against the claim or claims of all and every person whomsoever
claiming or to claim the same In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
