

Father Excepting what I have before conveyed to James Barnes lying and being in the district aforesaid & on the South Branches of Mountain Creek waters of Enore River it being part of a tract granted to Hardy Roberts by his Excellency Thomas Pinckney bearing date the first day of December 1788 Containing fifty acres more or less together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premise, belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have & to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James Roberts his heirs & assigns for ever & I do bind myself my heirs Executors administrators &c to warrant & for ever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto James Roberts his heirs &c against the claim of any person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 10 day of May in the year of our Lord 1800 signed in presence of James Roberts Jr William Roberts.

State of South Carolina <sup>3</sup> Know all men by these presents that I Aaron Springfield Greenville District <sup>3</sup> of the State & district aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to me paid in hand by Salathiel Clements of the State & district aforesaid have granted bargained sold & released & by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Salathiel Clements all that tract or parcel of land situate in the district of Greenville on the waters of the Bear Creek a branch of the River Beginning at Black Jack 3<sup>x</sup> on Early line thence Eastwardly on Young P. Pools line to a Hickory box on Kump's line thence southwardly on Kump's line to a black oak box on said line westwardly a crop wood creek to a post oak box on the road thence southwardly to a red oak box thence westwardly on said line to a Stake box on Early line thence on said line to the beginning containing two hundred acres be the same more or less being a part of a tract of land granted to Samuel Warren together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, appurtenances to the said premise, belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining thereto to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned to the said Salathiel Clements and do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Salathiel Clements his heirs or assigns against me and my heirs or any other person lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fourteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighteen signed sealed and delivered in presence of

Elliott Blandy, James Springfield.
