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State of South Carolina & District of Greenville I know all men by these presents that I John Hodges of the State of South Carolina and Dist. of Greenville hath bargained sold and delivered and do by these presents bargain sell and deliver unto Joseph McKinney of the State and Dist. aforesaid a certain tract or parcel of land containing 250 acres the same more or less being on the south fork of Tiger River in the State & Dist. aforesaid bounding as follows Beginning on a Red oak and running south 46° E 44' 1/2 to a Stake No. 44 N. 44. 72 to a post oak thence W. 40. N. 44. 72 to a Stake thence N. 44. E 44. 1/2 thence to the beginning corner joining lands of A. Smith on the S. E. an island of G. Woodward on the north land of J. Stanford on the N. land of L. Labon it being for the sum of nine Hundred dollars paid or to be paid unto the said John Hodges wherefore I bind my self my Heirs & C. to warrant and ever defend the rights and titles of the said land a wood water course to the said Joseph McKinney from all persons lawfully claiming the same signed in the presence of -

Lawnd of Charleston District in the State aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold and Released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Thomas O. Lawnd all that plantation and tract of land Situated, lying and being in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid beginning at a Stake on the road running N. 41. W. 9. ch. to a Spanish Oak thence N. 58. W. 8. 87. to a black oak, thence N. 38. W. 4. 38. to a black oak on the road, thence N. 17. W. 4. 10 ch. to a post oak, thence round the Valley along the dotted line laid down on the plat - S. 77. W. 14. ch. to the spring a chestnut corner, thence N. 83. W. 21. 40 by a poplar to a Chestnut corner, thence S. 61. W. 6. ch. to a sweet Gum thence S. 45. W. 7. ch. to a white oak thence S. 16. E. 17. ch. by a chestnut to a Stake, thence S. 72. E. 10. 40 to a black Gum, thence S. 5. E. 14. 72. ch. to a Stake thence S. 72. E. 15. ch. to a post oak, thence N. 72. E. 13. 72 to a Spanish Oak and thence N. 40. E. 33. 50 chains by two black oaks to the beginning corner at the road containing one hundred and fifty three acres more or less as by reference to the plat made by John Wats on Deputy Surveyor the 6th day of October 1827 and hereunto annexed will fully and at large appear bounded by the lands of Dr. William Butler, Capt Isaac Green Dr. Kirkland and Elisha Green Together with all and singular the Rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise inclosed or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Thomas O. Lawnd his heirs and assigns for ever. and I do hereby bind myself and my heirs Executors and administrators
