Wells his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns against myself, my heirs Executors Administrators and assigns and against every person or persons claiming or to claim the same or any part or parcel thereof And know ye further that for the consideration aforesaid I the said William Cox Young have assigned transferred and set over unto the said Obed H. Wells all and singular the debts due demanded accounts and notes and all other evidences of debts of what nature soever they may be which are or may be due, owing and coming to me on account of the said Greenville Republican and for this purpose and in order that the said Obed H. Wells may have the full benefit of the same have nominated, constituted and appointed, and by these presents do nominate constitute and appoint, Obed H. Wells my true and lawful attorney in and capable for the purpose of collecting and settling the same as fully and completely in every respect as I might or could, do and the proceeds to apply to his use exclusively, hereby giving and granting unto him all the power and authority for demanding, recovering, suing and receiving the same which I have or could have in the premises and ratifying and confirming all that he may do in the premises.
