 terial and apparatus herby Conveyed, unto the said Obed H. Wells his heirs  
 Executors Administrators and assigns against myself, my heirs Executors ad-  
 ministrators and assigns and against every person or persons claiming or  
 to claim the same or any part or parcel thereof And I know ye further  
 that for the consideration aforesaid I the said William Cox Young have  
 assigned Transferred and set over unto the said Obed H. Wells all and  
 singular the debts dues demands accounts and notes, and all other  
 evidences of debts of what nature soever they may be which are  
 or may be due, owing and coming to me on account of the said  
 Greenville Republican and for this purpose and in order that the  
 said Obed H. Wells may have the full benefit of the same have nom-  
 inated, Constituted and appointed, and by these presents do nominate  
 constitute and appoint, <sup>the 27<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1827</sup> Obed H. Wells my true and lawful attorney invo-  
 lable for the purpose of collecting and settling the same as fully and  
 completely in every respect as I might or could, do and the proceed to  
 apply to his use exclusively, herby giving and granting unto him all the po-  
 wer and authority for demanding, recovering, suing and receiving the same whi-  
 ch I have or could have in the premises and ratifying and con-  
 firming all that he may do in the premises. In witness whereof I
