Claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof Excepting a small piece  
sold to Aquilla Long to a conditional line made between Jordan Moore  
and said Long supposed to be three acres more or less as witness whereof  
I the said Jordan Moore do hereunto set my hand & seal this the twenty-  
first day of August one thousand eight hundred and twenty six -  
signed sealed and delivered in presence -

District & State aforesaid have bargained sold & by these presents do sell & release unto John  
Shomaker of state & district aforesaid all that part of a tract of land granted to sd Lawrence  
Brasher by his Excellency Charles Pinckney on the 24<sup>th</sup> of November 1807 containing  
Two hundred and ninety four acres the part to be conveyed part of the above con-  
tains one hundred & ninety five acres more or less being laid out to the  
sd John Shomaker as follows beginning on a sassafras corner on Joseph  
Jacksons line running on the original line of sd land N. 40 W. to a Stake thence  
on sd original on Aquilla Brashers line S. 75 W. 40 to a hickory thence S. 40 W.  
27 to a Stake thence S. 55 E. to a maple corner made between Lawrence Brasher  
& Joseph Jackson thence on a conditional line thro sd Survey to the Beginning  
including by estimation one hundred and ninety five Acres more or less together  
with all & singular the ways waters & all that appertains to the sd land & promises to the  
said John Shomaker his heirs & assigns for ever & lastly I the sd Lawrence Brasher for  
him self his heirs & assigns do warrant & for ever defend the aforesaid land & promises  
to the sd John Shomaker from all persons claiming the same or any part thereof as witness whereof I  
do hereby set my hand & seal this 12 day of August 1811. signed & delivered in presence
