W. 26. to a Stake 3x. bounded by James Cooley, thence S. 10 E. 31. to the beginning bounded by Elizabeth Vincent containing one hundred and Eighteen acres be the same more or less Together with all and singular the Rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To Have and to hold all and singular the premises unto the said Hiram Cooley his heirs and assigns for ever, and we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs Executors and administrators as Executors of said Estate to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Hiram Cooley his heirs and assigns against our selves and our heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully Claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
