 dollars to me in hand paid by John Whitt of the state and district aforesaid have
 Granted bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain
 and release unto the said John Whitt a plantation and tract or
 parcel of land, Containing one hundred and three acres be the same
 more or less situated and lying on the head branches of Mountain Creek
 waters of Saluda River. Beginning at Connors old line S. 10 E. 28. 50 to a P.
 3^x thence N. 85 E. 42 to a stake 3^x. thence N. 5 W. 20 to Connors old line thence N. 85
 W. 45. on Connors old line to the Beginning. Together with all and singular the
 Rights, members hereditaments and appurtenances to the sd premises belonging or
 in any wise Incident or pertaining to have and to hold all and singular
 the premises before mentioned unto the sd. John Whitt his heirs and assigns
 for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators
 to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the sd premises unto the
 sd. John Whitt his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against
 every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
 thereof - as witness my hand and seal this thirty first day of May one
 thousand eight hundred and twenty one and in the forty fifth year
 of the Independence of the United States of America signed sealed
 and delivered in the presence of,
