

George Gordon at or before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof shall be acknowledged by the said William Allston Hathgranted, bargained, sold, aliened, ^{conveyed and} released, confirmed, and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell, alien, release, conveyed and confirm unto the said George Gordon his heirs and assigns all those three certain lots or parcels of land situate lying and being in the Village of Greenville back house in the State of South Carolina. In a plan and distinguished in the plan of said Village by the numbers twenty seven (27), twenty eight (28) and thirty one (31) in the North West corner of said Village; also an addition of forty feet to be annexed to the upper or north side of lot number thirty one each of Exclusive of the forty feet to contain one hundred feet in main front by two hundred and thirty five feet deep as appears by the plans of Vardry Dobie of the said Village, filed in the Clerk's office at Greenville Court House in the said State of South Carolina.
