The State of South Carolina⁴²⁶ I know all men by these presents that we Thomas Love Greenville District Slop and Rebekah Lovelop of the State and district aforesaid in consideration of the sum of eight hundred and fifty dollars to us paid by Silas Gaines of the said State and district aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Silas Gaines all that plantation and tract of land lying in the state and district aforesaid on lime Creek waters of Saluda River. Beginning at a Stake 3^x thence running N. 20. E. 22 to a Stake 3^x bounded by Joseph McCullough's land thence S. 40. E. 21 to a Stake 3^x thence N. 50. E. 19. 50 to a red oak 3^x thence S. 74. E. 24. 50 to a Stake 3^x thence S. 40. E. 24. 50 to a Stake 3^x thence S. 50. E. 45 to a Stake bounded by Joseph McCullough & James Lovelop thence up the wagon Road to a red oak 3^x bounded by John Gambills land, thence N. 53. E. to the beginning Containing two hundred and seven acres be the same more or less. being part of a tract of land that belonged to the Estate of Samuel Nabours deceased to the said Thomas Lovelop and Rebekah Lovelop his wife as legatees of the Estate of Samuel Nabours dec'd by a decree at Greenville Court House together with all and singular the Rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises aforesaid mentioned unto the said Silas Gaines his heirs and assigns forever and we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Silas Gaines his heirs and assigns against ourselves and our heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming to to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness our hand and seal this twenty ninth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven and in the fifty second year of the Independence of the United States of America.
