37 thence S. 50. E. 45 to a Stake bounded by Joseph McCullough & James Lovelap thence up
The Wagon Road to a red oak 37 bounded by John Gambrell's land thence
N. 53. E. to the beginning. Containing two hundred and seven acres or the same more or
-less being part of a tract of land that belonged to the estate of Samuel Nabour
deceased to the said Thomas Lovelap and Rebeckah Lovelap his wife as legatus of the
