

! South Carolina To all To whom these presents  
Shall come I James McDaniel Sheriff of Greenville District and  
State aforesaid. And Greeting: Whereas by virtue of a Writ of Sheriff issued  
and served out of the Court of Common Pleas held for the district  
of Greenville tenth the twenty second day of May in the year of  
our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight - at  
the suit of William Tandy to me directed, commanding me that  
of the goods and chattles lands and tenments of William E Salmon  
on to levy the sum of twenty one dollars twelve and a half  
cents damages and costs I have seized and taken of the lands  
and tenments of the said William E Salmon all that certain  
piece parcel and tract of land containing twenty five acres  
in the same more or less. Situate and being in the District of Gre-  
enville. Beginning on an old pine stump on a conditional line  
thence with said line a southward course to a red oak corner marked  
by the Crop Roads at the head of a hollow. Thence down the hollow  
and branch a straight course to a Hickory 3x thence to the foot of  
the branch thence with the old Road an Eastwardly course as it  
meanders it being the line to a hickory 3x thence a straight course  
to the beginning also one other piece parcel or tract of land  
adjoining the above described premises that is to say on both  
sides of two small branches of Reedy River containing one  
hundred and forty seven acres to the same more or less.  
Beginning beginning at a post oak thence N. 14. 10. 9. ch. to a red  
oak thence N. 85 E. 14. ch. 75 links to a poplar to G. Hawkins  
land thence S. 78 E. 12. ch. 70 links to a post oak on said Hawkins  
land thence S. 10. W. 49 ch. to a stake by a hickory on Walker  
Salmon land thence south 65 W. 15. ch. 30 links on John Dunn  
cam land to a red oak thence W. 80 W. 8 ch. to a post oak  
stump between a chestnut and basswood. thence a  
conditional line near N. 12 W. 15 ch. to a red oak at a  
road thence N. 28. W. 15. ch. to a Black Gum thence south  
W. 8 E. 10 ch. to a red oak at a road thence on said road

piece or tract by John Salmon Ser. & recorded in Book J. in  
page 72 for the 25 day July 1812. and whereas the said pre-

have been exposed to sale at publick Virement and purchased  
by Allan R. Parkins of the District of Greenville for the sum  
of fifty dollars being the highest sum that was bid clear
