

And by these presents do grant bargain given and released unto the said Samuel Moore all that plantation or tracts of land whereon he now lives known as the Fork Shoals being a part of a survey originally granted to John Myrme in the District aforesaid on Ruddy Fork and Ruddy River including their Confluence containing one hundred and sixty five acres more or less Beginning on a Stake 3x on the East side of Ruddy River thence a cross said River S. 52 W. 33. 50 to a maple 3x thence on said Course to a Stake 3x thence N. 67. to 20 Chs to a Post Oak 3x thence thence N. 24. E. 8 Chs to a Post Oak Station thence N. 30 E. 49. 25. to a pine 3x thence S. 67. East. 35. to a Stake 3x on the East side of said River thence running down said River to the beginning corner including all the Waters of said River and the Mills thereon, together with all and singular the Rights, manners, tenements, and appurtenances to the premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Samuel Moore his heirs and assigns for ever and I do here by bind myself, my heirs, Executors and administrators, to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises, against myself, my heirs and assigns and every other person or persons, whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this October 17. 1826 Signed sealed and delivered in the presence of us.
