 a stake on the grapey branch, thence southwaly on a condition
 al line run by Thomas Springfield and David McDaniel &
 Jesse Griffin to a stake in McDaniel Spring branch, thence
 down sd branch to the beginning Together with all and
 singular the Rights members hereditaments to sd Land and premi
 ses belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to same
 and to hold all and singular the Land & premises unto the
 sd James Springfield his heirs and assigns for ever & I do hereby
 bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant &
 defend all and singular the sd Land & premises unto the sd
 James Springfield his heirs &c against myself my heirs or any
 other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to
