

One hundred dollars damages and costs I have seized and taken of
 the land and tenements of Daniel Cockrum all that certain piece
 parcel and tract of land containing... wherein he now lives situate
 and being in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid originally
 Granted to James West by his Excellency William Moultrie Governor
 & Commander in Chief in and over the said State on the 6th day of
 November one thousand seven hundred and Eighty six and
 duded by said James West to Hugchiah Cockrum conveyed
 by said Cockrum to Daniel Cockrum by deed of gift lying
 on the south side of Ready Fork waters of Ready River Beginning
 on a stake on the original line in a marsh corner of a piece
 of land duded to John Gordon running from thence down
 the marsh to where it intersects a branch that runs from
Isaac Roberts Spring thence down the branch to the creek
 thence down the Creek until a certain white oak will be in
 line with the next corner a possumen at the back of said Daniel
 Cockrum's smoke house from thence to the beginning enclosing the
 said parcel or tract of land And whereas the premises, with their
 appurtenance, since the seizure by me made by virtue of the said
 Writ of Hanc Hassas before mentioned, have been exposed to sale
 at public Vendue, and purchased by Jeremiah Cleveland
 of the said District of Greenville for the sum of one hundred
 and thirty dollars being the highest sum that was bid on therefore
 Now know ye that I James the Daniel Esqr Sheriff aforesaid
 by virtue of the said writ of Hanc Hassas aforesaid, to me directed
 and delivered as aforesaid, and by virtue of the Statute in such
 case made and provided and for and in consideration of the
 said sum of one hundred and thirty dollars to me in
 hand paid or bound to be paid by the said Jeremiah Cleveland
 the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge Have
 granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant
 bargain and sell unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland his
 heirs and assigns for ever, the said tract, piece and parcel of
 land, with its appurtenance and all the estate, right title
 and interest which the said Daniel Cockrum of right had of
 in and to the same to have and to hold the said piece, par-
 cel and tract of land with its appurtenance, unto the said
 Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns for ever, as fully and
 absolutely as the said James the Daniel might cause or
 ought to grant, bargain and sell the same, by virtue of the
 Statute aforesaid, and the said ^{writ of} Hanc Hassas or otherwise —
