

Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Ferguson for and in consideration of the said debt as aforesaid to the said Wickleff and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Wickleff for and in consideration of the aforesaid sum of Ninety one dollars ninety six Cents in hand paid at and before the Sealing and delivering of these presents do grant bargain and sell alien & Release Bankey and confirm unto the said Wickleff and his heirs and assigns and from every other person lawfully claiming or to claim the same Five Heather heads or furniture one Loom one Table & sets brockery one hand saw and drawing knife one pair drawing chains two axes two Pots and one oven one large Iron Kettle five Head hogs & two Cows and balls together with all and singular the Rights numbers and appurtenances there to belonging to his heirs and assigns forever provided always nevertheless and it is the true intent and meaning of the parties to these presents that if the said Ferguson his heirs Executors or administrators shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Wickleff his heirs or assigns the before mentioned sum by the first December of the present year then and from thence forward these presents shall be utterly null and void any thing herein contained to the contrary ther of in any wise notwithstanding and it is also covenanted and agreed between the parties to these presents that until default of payment shall be made of the aforesaid sum as before set forth for the said Ferguson Peaceably and quietly to hold use and occupy possess and enjoy all and singular the property before mentioned and every part thereof any thing contained herein before in any wise notwithstanding I'm witness whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal this day and year first above written (Intended in the presence of) J.
